On March 26, 2016, Raphael Gennaoui was delivered, ghost white and lifeless into the world. He suffered catastrophic brain damage due to hypoxia just prior to his delivery and his life expectancy was expected to be days. He defied all odds and survived. Now at almost two years old, he is fighting every day to overcome the delays associated with the cerebral palsy and epilepsy he has as a result of his birth.

Early intervention with consistent and varied therapies is required to help Raphy achieve things we all take for granted – swallowing, talking, walking and play – and the treatment he receives between birth and his 4th birthday are the most critical. This includes daily occupational, speech and physiotherapy as well as 4 intensive therapy workshops per year. Aside from hospital expenses, Raphael's treatment is not covered by health insurance and the family's out of pocket medical expenses alone exceed \$100k per year.
